

SHOPS

Each Barber must have:

Tall {clear} Barbicide jar with EPA-registered disinfectant solution

Disinfectant spray

Tool drawer: only barbering tools----no keys, phones, candy, papers, money, clipper oil, hair products, etc.

10 to 12 combs

Hazardous waste container for discarding razor blades. No soda bottles or cups, etc.

If you use a neck duster keep it clean. Wash with soap and water when needed.

Barbers must have their barber license at their station. ID cards are not acceptable.

If a Barber works at 2 shops he should get a Duplicate License. Cost is \$20.00

Barber Shops must have one sink for every two chairs. **Barbers must be within 6' of a sink with hot and cold water.** Send with your application **photos** of your shop showing all barber chairs within 6' of a sink. You will not have to wait for an inspection we will mail license to you.

Barber shops that hire Cosmetologists must also have a Cosmetology shop license. Contact the Cosmetology Board. 480-784-4539

When you leave for the day, clean your work station and place all tools in clean tool drawer including your neck duster. Wash combs with soap and water, rinse and place in barbicide jar. Empty your trash can. Fold chair cloth and place on barber chair rack or chair arm. Remove all clutter.

The holder of a license to operate a shop shall designate a Barber to directly supervise the shop during all hours of operation.
